



### **THE LYNN PERROTT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Lynn Perrott served as the Region 7 Regional Administrative Chair from 1997-2014. Her first joy was working with the athletes in our region, and she worked to support their participation in the sport at all levels. She took pride in watching our athletes reaching their goals in the sport of gymnastics, and continuing their gymnastics careers in college. Lynn had a positive outlook on life, even in the face of her illness. She will be remembered by her sense of humor and smile that she shared with the athletes, coaches and judges in Region 7. Lynn's background in gymnastics began in dance, and she had a great appreciation for artistry expressed by our athletes. It is a fitting tribute to Lynn to offer a Memorial Scholarship in her name that will assist an athlete to continue to pursue her academic goals in college, and athletic goals in gymnastics.

The 2019 Lynn Perrott Memorial Scholarship will be offered in the amount of \$5,000. to an eligible candidate that best fits the criteria offered by Lynn's family and the Region 7 Administrative Committee.

To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

- Level 8-10 Womens Artistic Gymnastics gymnast from Region 7-currently competing in the Junior Olympic program
- Graduating Senior
- Plans to attend college
- Has not received a scholarship for gymnastics

## **Review and Award Process**

A review committee will review and rank applicants, with a final decision to be announced after June 1.

- Acceptance of the scholarship by the candidate will be contingent upon the athlete verifying continued eligibility based on the application eligibility criteria.
- If the scholarship recipient plans to continue competing gymnastics in college, it is recommended that she contact the compliance officer at the academic institution to disclose the scholarship award and confirm that the award will comply with NCAA guidelines.
- The scholarship recipient will provide the Region 7 RAC the name of the college/university, student identification number, and the address where the scholarship award will be mailed.
- A letter from USA Gymnastics will accompany the scholarship check, with the recipient's identification information, so that her college account will be credited accordingly.

The scholarship recipient will be recognized at her club banquet or at the Region 7 Regional Congress, June 21-23, 2019 in Harrisburg, PA
